


2.	28-08-2024	<p>Today, Mr. Mohsin Amin, the complainant, appeared before the Commission and was heard in person. He reiterated his complaint that his brand-new motorcycle was snatched on gunpoint on 23/02/2023 within the jurisdiction of Gulbahar Police Station. The concerned Police Station recorded the incident in the <i>roznamcha</i>, but no FIR has been registered till date. He further alleged that the police initially provided him with Rs. 20,000/- as compensation, but later SHO took back the said money. He also stated that he possesses CCTV footage of the incident, which he showed to the Commission during the hearing. While the police on face of such cogent evidence has not registered FIR, nor any action has been taken till date. Additionally, the complainant mentioned that he submitted an application to the SSP Operations, but no response has been received (copies enclosed).</p> <p>As FIR is a notified public service under the RTPS Act, 2014, and that the SSP Operations Peshawar is the Appellate Authority, and the complainant has already submitted a first appeal to the SSP Operations. Copy of the complaint alongwith enclosures is hereby sent to SSP Operations with the directions to Immediately register the FIR for the incident, under intimation to this Commission, and also to inquire into the delay of delivery of this service the report of which too be submitted to the Commission.</p> <p> Commissioner-II</p> <p> Commissioner-I</p>
